

ST JOHN OF JERUSALUM EYE-HOPSITAL NEWS

E.Kt. Jamie Ingham-Clark CStJ, Past Dep. Gt.Swd. B. Trustee of the Jerusalem eye Hospital

Nothing like diving in at the deep end at William Warde Preceptory! On the 8th March 2024 I became its newest joining member, and then was immediately asked to give a talk about the St John Eye Hospital in Jerusalem, of which I have been a trustee of some 6 years.

The talk was entitled Current Successes and Challenges. It included a brief outline of the history of the Hospital, why the KT has been such a long supporter, some of the key success landmarks including being awarded the António Champalimaud Vision Prize - the most prestigious prize in the field of vision.

I went on to give a personal insight as to the current situation in Gaza and the steps the Board of Trustees are planning to take once the current hostilities cease.

At the end a lively Q&A session took place which allowed further personal insights regarding the running of the Hospital.

The meeting concluded with a vote of funds to the Hospital.

Under AOB the preceptory was advised on another joining member to be voted on at the next meeting.


