MASONIC KNIGHTS TEMPLAR PRESENTATION TO NESTOR LODGE NO. 8184 (Bucks)

On Tue 19 Mar 24, the Oxon, Berks & Bucks Presentation Team gave a very interesting presentation about Masonic Knights Templar, to Nestor Lodge No. 8184, who meet at the Masonic Centre in St Peter Street, Marlow in Bucks,.

The Team, consisting of Eminent Knights Bob Diplock, Provincial Vice Chancellor, and Graham Snell, Registrar of Cygnet Preceptory No. 464, was warmly welcomed by the Worshipful Master, W. Bro. Mark P. Iwaszko and his Brethren before giving an informative talk - consisting of a short film and slideshow - about the medieval Order of the Poor Fellow Soldiers of Christ and the Temple of Solomon and their spiritual descendants; modern Masonic Knights Templar.

E Kts Bob and Graham responded by saluting the Worshipful Master and his Officers with their swords before taking their place in the Lodge for the remainder of the meeting. Worshipful Brother Mark P. Iwaszko later said:

'With the amazing support of E. Kt Bob and E.Kt Graham, we facilitated a compelling presentation to twenty-nine Craft Masons across all degrees who had expressed great interest in learning more about this Order. There were seventeen visitors, from twelve different Lodges, across several provinces, enabling a rare insight into the fascinating history and continued spiritual values within the Knights Templar.'

ST JOHN OF JERUSALEM EYE-HOPSITAL NEWS

E.Kt. Jamie Ingham-Clark KStJ, Past Dep. Gt.Swd.B. Trustee of the Jerusalem eye Hospital

I am delighted to report a very small but significant step in our desire to deliver eye care to Gaza which has been non-existent since the start of the war on 7th October.

We have been given permission to set up an eye clinic in three different locations within the Gaza Strip, in the north, south and in the centre. These clinics will only be able to deliver eye drops at this stage, but it is a real step in the right direction.

It represents stage one of our three phase plan to return to delivering the services we did before the start of the war. The next stage will be to return the hospital building to a useable state and following that to resume our operating facilities there.

All of this will depend on a resolution to the ongoing situation, but it means we will be ready to act as soon as conditions allow.

In the meantime, I would like to thank all our Brother Knights for their continued support for our work and I look forward to seeing many of you at our new Provincial Prior's Installation.




