REPRESENTING THE CYGNET PRECEPTORY No. 464 AT THE CHURCH SERVICE By Kt. Sunny Sagoo

As many Brother Knights will be aware, on Sunday 8th June, a special Church Service was held at St. Helen's Church, in the Parish of Abingdon-on-Thames, Oxfordshire. In the weeks leading up to this event, E.Kt. Graham Snell, who has been commendably engaged in humanitarian efforts in Ukraine, reached out to members of Cygnet Preceptory, No. 464, offering the chance to represent the Preceptory at the Service. I sharply stepped forward to offer my assistance. This was met with warm appreciation. I'm no stranger to banner bearing; I previously carried the banner of my Craft Lodge, Chalfont St. Peter, No. 9656, during the Investiture of Tim Anders, the new Provincial Grand Master, which was attended by over 500 Freemasons from across the country assembled in the Grand Temple of Freemasons' Hall!



A few days prior to the Church Service, my brother Kt. Ranj and I collected the banner and its pole components from the Beaconsfield Masonic Centre and figured out how to assemble it — this was completely new to us! I fixed corks to the ends of the sharp spearheads on both sides of the crossbar, for safe transport, as we Masons are taught to be cautious. A few days later on a bright, warm Sunday morning, Ranj and I made our way to St. Helen's Church, which was over an hour's drive for us. Upon our arrival, we were absolutely captivated by the stunning historical architecture. I immediately began taking snaps. Banner bearers from Preceptories across our Province were in attendance and it was a great pleasure meeting all of them. Under the direction of Eminent Knights such as Dave Parry, we were organised and prepared for the parade.

Promptly at 2:30pm, the Service began. The banner bearers were commanded to commence their duties. Each of us brought our respective banners to the front of the stage and secured them in their stands before making our way to our reserved pews. Fortunately, our performance went very well! Subsequently, the esteemed Bodyguards of the Provincial Prior, of which I am a proud member, as is my elder brother Ranj, under the excellent direction of our great Bodyguard Commander Kt. ST JOHN OF JERUSALEM EYE-HOSPITAL NEWS

E.Kt. Jamie Ingham Clark KStJ, Past Dep. Gt.Swd.B. Trustee of the Jerusalem Eye Hospital

Dear Knights,

The Hospital continues to provide care where it can.

I am pleased to report that somehow we have been able to reclaim the Hospital Building in Gaza and have been able to refurbish the ground floor well enough to start using it as a base for our clinics. This means that for the first time in many months we are not reliant on other agencies to support clinics and they are no longer based in tents with all the lack of hygiene such accommodation brings.

Unfortunately due to the way aid is now being distributed, we have not have a resupply of medicine the cease fire collapsed, so the care we are providing there is many palliative.

Last week I had the privilege to attend the Hertfordshire Provincial Priory Annual Meeting. Amongst other things I reminded them of why we use the swift as a symbol. Thise I talked to there found it a useful reminder as many had forgotten. So I thought I would repeat it here.

The swift migrates many thousands of miles between its summer and winter feeding areas. Many migrate through the Holy Land. They therefore are symbolic messengers of the HOPE which the Hospital provides to many in the Holy Land, where eye disease is 10 times more prevalent than in the UK, and where blindness makes you a drain on already scarce family resources.

Once again I thank Brother Knights for their unstinting support of our work and wish you a Happy Summer until we reconvene in September.
